Guidelines and Conditions of Entry

Subject matter:

- **The flora, fauna, habitat, or landforms of the region.**
Artists are encouraged to relate their subject to a specific biodiversity sustainability theme or issue.

The region is defined by the extent of the original lava flows of the **Mt.Warning/Wollumbin shield volcano**. This includes the Tweed valley, the surrounding escarpments and beyond to include Lismore and Byron Bay to the south, out to sea in the east, the Kyogle area in the west, and north to Beaudesert, Tamborine and Southport. (refer p24, *Tweed Volcanic Region*, BW Graham 2001) or email info@calderaart.org.au for map.

Exhibits must **not** contain any natural **animal** items such as feathers, fur, bones, shells, eggs, etc. Plant fibres and leaves are acceptable.

The supporting statement is to provide the audience with further depth of understanding of the subject matter. It may be purely factual or reflect personal observations, experiences or interpretation.

It must be a minimum of 70 words in length and absolute maximum 130 words (if longer than 130 words, the entry may become ineligible).

The websites of **Tweed, Byron, Lismore, Ballina, Scenic Rim and Gold Coast Councils** are an excellent source of information for local, specific natural environment management and sustainability related matters. The Caldera Art website also lists numerous links to other sources of information.

Artists are encouraged to exhibit any preparatory field sketches, notes and/or reference material to further engage the audience with the subject matter.

All sketches, notes, etc are to be contained within an A4 sized display folder.

NB. This is an optional project and will not be part of the judging process.

Sales:

All artworks are to be for sale and will attract a 25% sales commission.

Artists are encouraged to also have their own merchandise for sale (cards, prints, etc., which must be a derivative of the artist's personal work). Further information will be included in the July newsletter.

Insurance:

All care will be taken in the handling and security of original artworks and merchandise, but they will **not** be insured against damage or loss. **Caldera Regional Arts Inc, Tweed Shire Council, Ballina Shire Council, Currumbin Wildlife Sanctuary and Tweed Tourism Inc will not accept any responsibility for loss or damage to items whilst in their care.** Each artist is responsible for their own insurance cover.

Specifications:

Artwork may be in any style and/or medium, including sculpture, craft and photography. Up to two works may be entered, and been created in 2009 or 2010.

Size restrictions for 2D: 1.3m height max. x 1.3m width max. (including all framing)
For 3D: 1.3m h x 1.3m w x 0.7m depth (not including plinth) and not more than 25kg

Image/s on the CD (one for 2D and two for 3D max please) must be a true representation of the original artwork, and 300dpi (jpeg or tiff format) at A4. The files are to be identified with your name and title of work, and please ensure the CD itself is marked with your name. For assistance with photographing artworks please contact Alan & Perri Wain vibrant@internode.on.net.

Each attachment to emailed entries not to exceed 2MB in file size.

Entry fee is \$20 for one, and \$30 for two entries (this assists with the publication of the 48 page Caldera Art 2010 Catalogue).

Entries close 4pm Friday 20th August (postmarked, emailed, or delivered).

Selection process:

A pre-selection panel and jury appointed by Caldera Art will review the submitted digital images/statements and select 115* artworks for the Caldera ArtFest using the following criteria:

How effectively has the artist interpreted and communicated their specific subject, theme or issue.

All entrants will be notified (by 5th Sept) of the outcome and, if applicable, requested to deliver the work to the venue on the morning of Thursday 30th Sept.(further details regarding delivery of works TBA).

From these works, the jury will select 95 (including 43 to be published in the Caldera 2010 book) to form the touring exhibitions (refer CA website for details). These works will be identified at the opening of the ArtFest.

The final total prizemoney (\$8,000+) and number of prizes and awards will be announced in the July CA newsletter.

The decision of the jury is final on all aspects of selection and awarding of prizes, and no correspondence or appeal will be considered.

*In 2009, 110 works were selected from 125 entries
