

Dave is a full time landscape artist based in the mountains of southeast Queensland where the Groom family has lived since the 1930's (grandfather Arthur Groom established Binna Burra Lodge in Lamington National Park). This has fostered a deep connection to the landscape.

He has had solo exhibitions that concentrate on particular regions and landscapes promoting biodiversity values and conservation initiatives. These include an exhibition of the Coomera River landscape in Lamington National park and Caldera – The Wollumbin Landscape which was an exhibition of the Mt Warning Region.

In 2006 and 2007 Dave was involved with the Beechmont based Ethos Foundation, raising awareness of the biodiversity of the region and the value of the natural environment.

Over the last 5 years Dave has conducted a number of drawing workshops both at Binna Burra Lodge and in Boonah, concentrating on the landscape.
